- Objective: The RBI is India's central banking institution, which controls the issuance and supply of the Indian Rupee. Since it oversees the banking sector of India, it is also known as the Banker's Bank.
- It has the following functions:
 - Issuer of Currency
 - Managing money for the Government
 - Custodian of Forex Reserves
 - Custodian of Cash reserves
 - Controls credit by changing different rates


